Savoury Scones

Classes 16 – MEN ONLY

Makes 6

- 225g self-raising flour
- 75g butter
- 1 egg
- 2 tablespoons milk, plus a little more for brushing
- A pinch of salt and pepper
- Flavouring of your choice

Preheat the oven to 200°C/400°F/gas 6 (conventional oven temperatures)

Start by sifting the flour into a mixing bowl. Add a pinch of salt and pepper. Rub in the butter – using your fingertips – until the mixture is crumbly. Alternatively, pulse the flour, salt and pepper and butter in a food processor until they start to look like breadcrumbs. Tip into a bowl and make a well in the middle.

In another bowl, beat the egg and milk with a fork and pour into the well. Add your flavouring and mix the flour into the egg and milk, adding a little more milk if needed, until you have a soft, dry dough.

Roll out the dough on a floured surface to a thickness of about 2.5cm. Cut out circles from the dough with a 6cm cutter and place on a well-greased baking sheet. Brush the top of each scone with the extra milk and bake in the oven for 15-20 minutes, until risen and brown.

Cool on a wire rack.

- Children's work to be their own, age to be stated.
- The judges' decision is final.
- Certificates, rosettes and prizes will be awarded at judges discretion, cups are presented for best in section.
- Exhibits must be removed and prizes collected between 17.00 and 18.00 on the day of the show.
- The committee cannot be held responsible for any exhibits and/or containers.
- All cups must be collected and signed for before the end of the show.
- All cups must be returned, in a clean condition, to a committee member two weeks prior to the next year's show.

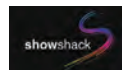
