18/128	District and County Council Report
	<p>Hampshire County Council:- Cllr Bennison reported the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Farnborough Airshow's biennial event saw traffic management during 2018 much improved on previous years. Farnborough are contracted to hold the event in 2020. b) Closure of Beacon Hill Road from its junction with Tadpole Lane was expected to start today. Diversions would be in place offering Sandy Lane as a diversion. Although the Order was for 6 months, work was not expected to take longer than one day as BT Open Reach carry out cabling works. Their presence hasn't been seen today. c) A number of water leaks, within the Parish, have been identified and reported to relevant Agencies. Its import to ensure these are rectified before any significant drop in temperature resulting in freezing. <p>Hart District Council:- Cllr Tony Clarke raised Planning Application 17/02369/HOU which relates to Grazings Farm, Redlands Lane but acknowledged that it was an Agenda item.</p>

	<p>The following Planning Applications have been received:-</p> <p>18/01929/HOU demolition of existing garage and construction of new garage with master bedroom, first floor side extension to replace balcony at Homecroft Farm, Church Lane, Ewshot, Surrey GU10 5BJ. The Council felt that the proposed planning application offers a design in keeping with the village, which flows nicely and the entrance remains in the same location. No objection offered.</p> <p>17/02369/HOU proposed 5 bedroom dwelling including detached garage following demolition of existing redundant agricultural building. Siting of replacement stables at Grazings Farm, Redlands Lane, Ewshot, Farnham, Surrey GU10 5AR The Council wish to offer no comment to this application.</p>
18/132	Traffic Calming for the Village and Community Speedwatch
	There was no update to report on this. Cllrs Bennison confirmed that the installation of the new posts is on his list to follow through. The summer is a very quiet time of the year. Once the posts are installed we can then apply to borrow the SID again which, the Lengthsman can install as previously.
18/133	New Noticeboard for Badger Way and Doras Green
	The new noticeboards were still waiting to be sign written. The Chairman continues to chase.
18/134	Hedge Cutting, Ewshot Recreation Ground
	Paulson had carried out some hedge cutting within the recreation ground. There has been some post damage in the process. It was also noted that some hedge cutting around the village hall & within the playground would be required.

	After receiving notice that hornets were presenting a problem within the playground area the Parish Council sought the services of Blue Light Pest Control. Once on site they also discovered a wasp problem. Both were dealt with effectively.

	<p>Village Hall Car Park Entrance - A couple of quotations to tarmac the car park entrance will be available for the next Parish Council Meeting in October.</p>
	<p>Dog Fouling - Really difficult to police. Dog poo bag stations along with dog poo bins are sited around the recreation ground, by the tennis courts and near the entrance to the SANG Land. EPC are in touch with HDC & Environmental Department, Dog Warden etc.</p>
	<p>SANG Land - The village car park is being used by visitors and dog walkers to the SANG Land. Although we cannot stop car parking for this purpose we can charge and Adam Green will offer some financial assistance to help us enforce this.</p>
	<p>Tennis Court Bin - Cllr Taylor proposed that EPC purchase a new bin for the Tennis Courts as the existing one is beyond repair. It was unanimously agreed to purchase a new bin.</p>
	<p>Bus Shelter Roof Shingle - Cllr Cranstone advised the Clerk that he would send through the details of the shingle required for the bus shelter roof. The volunteer, who has kindly offered to undertake the work, would collect the material directly, once Clerk authorises.</p>
