18/159	District and County Council Report
	<p>Hampshire County Council:- Cllr Bennison said that there was nothing much to report regarding our Parish. He advised that HCC are implementing, as part of their spending cuts, to switch off street lights for 3 hours between the hours of 1.00 a.m. and 4.00 a.m. from April 2019. The saving, in energy costs, will be £230,000, see a reduction in the authority's carbon dioxide output of 720 tonnes per year, saving £12,960 in avoided carbon tax.</p> <p>Doras Green Lane is due to be closed for one week from the 26th November. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along that length of Doras Green Lane from its junction with Heath Lane to its junction with Crondall Lane. The closure will enable BT Openreach to can carry out necessary works.</p> <p>Hart District Council:- Cllr Clarke had nothing to report.</p>

Access via existing driveway. Resubmission of 17/00604/FUL – Woodpeckers, Church Lane, Ewshot, Farnham GU10 5BD. It was AGREED that there was no requirement to comment on this Planning Application.
18/162	Traffic Calming for the Village and Community Speedwatch
	a) Community Speedwatch - Cllr Jennings contacted Claire Inglis enquiring as to the feasibility of Ewshot borrowing their SID. It transpires that Church Crookham don't have their own SID they share with another Parish. It was AGREED that the Clerk would contact HDC to ask if we could, as previously, borrow one or two of their SIDs. The Lengthsman could pick them up from HDC and install as previously.
18/163	New Noticeboard for Badger Way and Dora's Green
	The two new Noticeboards have been delivered and are currently in the Parish Office. Volunteers are treating them both and they will be installed, weather permitting, between Christmas and New Year. The Chairman confirmed that the Badger's Way Noticeboard has also been agreed & confirmed.

	The Q2 Financial Accounts, as circulated to Council, were approved and signed accordingly.
18/165	S106 Funds
	Following receipt of an email from Daryl Phillips on the 1 st November advising that, following a review of the S106 funds, which HDC holds for parish related leisure projects collected over the years, Ewshot has £25,778. Hart are keen to see that

these funds have some spending plans attached to them otherwise we cannot justify taking further contributions. There is also the risk of the monies being return to the developers if not allocated to suitable projects within the Parish. Initial ideas were Playground and Car Park projects.
